

THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

124th Ave. NE & Firloch Ave. NE (NE 85th St. to NE 128th St.)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

124th Ave. NE & Firloch Ave. NE

be established not less than 84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Commencing at a point on the centerline of NE 85th St., said point being N. 63°52'16"W., a distance of 286.51 Ft. from the southeast corner of the NE¼ of the SW¼ of Section 4, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.W., thence in a northerly direction a distance of 13,990.98 Ft. to a terminus on the west line of the NW¼ of the NW¼ of Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., said terminus being S. 1°57'51"W., a distance of 318.40 ft., thence So. 26°17'28"E., a distance of 1104.36 Ft. from the northwest corner of said section 28, said terminus also being the intersection of NE 128th St.

13,990.98 ft. = 2.65 miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
