THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

120th Avenue NE (North 636.98 feet to NE 132nd Street)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as

120th Avenue NE

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point 636.98 feet southerly from centerline of NE 132nd Street said point being engineers station 9+37.02 in Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M. thence N 1° 50' 44" E a distance of 636.98 feet to a terminus on a centerline of NE 132nd Street said terminus being N 1° 50' 44" E a distance 18.68 feet and S 89° 53' 48" W distance of 1,335.07 feet from the NW corner of said Section 28.

636.98 Feet = 0.121 Mile

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
