

MOTION NO. 542

WHEREAS, the communication industry has demonstrated the ability to establish and operate an effective emergency communication system 911,

WHEREAS, that industry has indicated that such a 911 System is feasible, generally in suburban King County,

WHEREAS, a 911 System facilitates significantly the improvement of existing and contemplated systems of emergency response,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Council of King County, Washington, that the County Council declares its intent to establish a County-wide 911 System, and that the County Executive is authorized to enter into such agreements as are required to implement a County-wide 911 System.
