1           WHEREAS, The Young Men's Christian Association is well known  
2 for its outstanding activities in the development of Christian  
3 character in the lives of young people, and

4           WHEREAS, the week of January 21st will be observed as  
5 National Y. M. C. A. Week, and

6           WHEREAS, the Y. M. C. A. is adopting new goals which include:  
7 Eliminating "personal and institutional racism"; "changing the  
8 conditions that foster alienation, delinquency and crime";  
9 "reducing health problems, both physical and mental"; "strengthening
