A MOTION appointing a liaison from the King County Council to the 1973 State Legislative Branch and allowing certain expenditures therefore.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature convened in session January 8, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Intent of the King County Council for 1972 and 1973 included extensive requests for state legislation affecting the operation of King County, and

WHEREAS, the effect of state legislation has a great impact on County Government, the King County Council and its Legislative Committee find it necessary to establish full time liaison with the state legislative bodies,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Jon B. Louis, King County Council Legislative Aide, is hereby authorized to establish liaison, testify, and communicate with legislators and State Government, under the direction of the Council Legislative Committee, during the 1973 Legislative Session, and that his living expenses and support services for this activity shall not exceed Twenty-five Hundred Dollars.
