A MOTION authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Safety to offer law enforcement agencies within King County, on a space available basis, participation in the Department's traffic safety training program.

WHEREAS, the National Highway Safety Act of 1966 (P.L.89-564) directed that each state have a highway safety program with the Governor of each state responsible for the program administration, and

WHEREAS, the 1967 Washington State Legislature provided for the establishment of the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (R.C.W.43.59) in carrying out the provisions of the National Highway Safety Act of 1966, and

WHEREAS, the Washington Traffic Safety Commission, in accordance with the provisions of R.C.W.43.59, has authorized and directed all Washington state counties and municipalities of 10,000 or more population to prepare comprehensive traffic safety programs; and has directed that counties provide coordination and planning assistance for those municipalities of less than 10,000 population residing within their borders, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council has established, by Motion 733, the Office of Traffic Safety Coordination as the means of implementing these provisions, and

WHEREAS, the King County Department of Public Safety has developed and is presenting to its law enforcement personnel on-going traffic safety training including, but not limited to, first aid, defensive driving, accident investigation, record systems, traffic court procedure, and radar and breathalyzer operation, and

WHEREAS, law enforcement to be most effective requires close cooperation and coordination among the various municipal and county law enforcement personnel,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The Director of the Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to offer law enforcement agencies within King County, on a space available basis, participation in the Department's traffic safety training program.
