2 A MOTION expressing Council approval of the  
3 City of Seattle Hearing Examiner's recommendation  
4 to approve the increases in rates and charges for  
5 cable television services established by Teleprompter  
6 within unincorporated King County, effective  
7 October 1, 1975.

9 WHEREAS, the Seattle City Council and the King County Council are  
10 authorized by ordinances and franchise agreements to regulate rates and  
11 services relative to cable television services, and

12 WHEREAS, the Teleprompter Corporation, on October 1, 1975 increased its  
13 primary monthly subscriber rates within the City of Seattle and within  
14 unincorporated King County from \$7.95 to \$8.50 per month, and

15 WHEREAS, both the Seattle City Council and the King County Council on  
16 their own motions, delegated to the Seattle Hearing Examiner the authority  
17 to hold a public hearing to review the rate increases and forward to the  
18 respective councils the complete record of the proceedings together with the  
19 written recommendation based on the findings and conclusions, and

20 WHEREAS, the hearing to review the rate increases for Teleprompter was  
21 held at 9:30 am and 1:30 pm, respectively on February 19, 1976, and

22 WHEREAS, the City Hearing Examiner's Conclusions of Law found the rate  
23 increases placed in effect by Teleprompter to be in the public interest and  
24 recommended that they should be allowed to remain in effect, and


25 WHEREAS, the City Hearing Examiner recommends that the Seattle City  
26 Council and the King County Council should approve the rate increases  
27 established by Teleprompter within the City of Seattle and within unincorporated  
28 King County effective October 1, 1975.

29 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
