3 anniversary of the Boeing Field/King
4 County International Airport and pro-
claiming the week of July 24, 1978
as Aviation Week.

5 WHEREAS, The citizens of King County acquired and dedicated
6 the King County Airport on July 26, 1928, and

7 WHEREAS, King County named its Airport Boeing Field in honor
8 of William E. Boeing, Sr., on July 26, 1928, and

9 WHEREAS, The first manned heavier-than-air flight in the
10 Pacific Northwest occurred at property which is now Boeing Field,
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Boeing Field/King County International Airport
13 has contributed significantly to the history of aviation in King
14 County and throughout the World, and

15 WHEREAS, Boeing Field launched the U.S. into the Jet Age by
16 providing flightline support of 707, 727, 737, and 747 aircrafts;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, Boeing Field is 10th busiest airport in U.S.A., and

19 WHEREAS, Boeing Field provides important public support fac-
20 ilities including Federal Aviation Administration Region Head-
21 quarters, University of Washington research, Washington State
22 Division of Aeronautics, emergency service between aircraft and
23 hospitals, and a myriad of other public services, and

24 WHEREAS, Boeing Field provides important support for the
25 business and commercial community and employment for thousands;

26 WHEREAS, The first airline flight with an airline stewardess
27 flew from Boeing in 1930, and

28 WHEREAS, Boeing Field is unique in providing 50 years of
29 continuous service as a civilian airport, and

30 WHEREAS, the week of May 15, 1978 is National Transportation
31 Week, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes the role of the Boeing Field/King County International Airport essential in the County's overall transportation system.


