A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into the attached agreement with the State of Washington for the purpose of eradicating or controlling Tansy Ragwort Weeds.

WHEREAS, King County has recognized the need to control the spread of Tansy Ragwort Weed, and

WHEREAS, joint efforts by the State of Washington, King County and individual landowners is the best way to develop and demonstrate methods for control of Tansy Ragwort;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Executive is authorized to enter into and carry out the provisions of the attached agreement (Attachment A) which will establish a cost-sharing program by the landowner, King County and the State of Washington whereby each participant will pay one-third of the cost of the pilot spraying program.

BETWEEN
STATE OF WASHINGTON

KING COUNTY
CONCERNING
TANSY RAGWORT PILOT PROGRAM FOR 1978

Agreement between the State Department of Agriculture and King County concerning Department of Agriculture funds appropriated by the Washington State Legislature pursuant to Chapter 339, 86, Subsection 1, Laws of 1977, 1st ex. session, for the purpose of eradicating or controlling tansy ragwort weeds.

This agreement is made and entered into by the Department of Agriculture and King County for the express purpose set forth in the following provisions of this contract.

WHEREAS, the eradication and control of tansy ragwort is necessary to maintain an adequate supply of agricultural crops and products and the general health of livestock, and

WHEREAS, joint efforts by counties, the Department of Agriculture and individual landowners is the best way to develop and demonstrate methods for the control of tansy ragwort, and

WHEREAS, the King County Noxious Weed Control Board, acting in cooperation with King County, has full knowledge of the agricultural lands infested with tansy ragwort and the landowners who would be willing to cooperate in a pilot program to control or eradicate tansy ragwort on agricultural lands, and

WHEREAS, King County has provided one third of the funds necessary to carry out this program in King County, and

1 4) That King County, through the King County Noxious Weed Control
2 Board, will compensate each participating landowner in the pilot program
3 by paying two thirds of said landowner's costs with one third to be paid
4 from the money made available by the County; and

5 5) That any funds received from the Department of Agriculture by
6 King County to carry out said pilot program and not expended by December 31,
7 1978 shall be returned to the Department of Agriculture.
