

MOTION NO. 5277

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to quitclaim County Road right-of-way in Council District No. 9 to the State Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, King County is the record owner of right-of-way within the limits of SR 515, SSH 5-A (SR 516) to Renton; and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, Department of Transportation plans improvement of State Route 515, SSH 5-A (SR 516) to Renton; and

WHEREAS, in the improvement of SR 515, it is necessary and advisable for the State of Washington to acquire title to the County right-of-way within the limits of the highway project; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration by the County Council of the County of King, it appears to the said County Council that it will be for the best interests of both the County of King and the State of Washington that the County of King convey the right-of-way to the State of Washington by Quit Claim Deed for a consideration of MUTUAL BENEFITS.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized in accordance with RCW 47.12.040 to quitclaim to the State of Washington, Department of Transportation, the following described lands for mutual benefits for a right of way for State Highway:

The East 20 feet of the West 50 feet of the South 150 feet of the North 180 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter;

The East 20 feet of the West 50 feet of the North 120 feet of the South 872.91 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter;

The East 20 feet of the West 50 feet of the North 265.78 feet of the South 752.91 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter;

The East 20 feet of the West 50 feet of the North 310 feet of the South 440 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter;

AND


The East 20 feet of the West 50 feet of the following:
The West 3/4 of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter Less the South 440 feet, and less the South 9.5 Acres thereof; and less the North 180 feet of the West

1 150 feet thereof; and less the East 370 feet thereof;

2 All in Section 8, Township 22 North, Range 5 East,
