A MOTION relating to the Community Development Block Grant Program adopting the 1986 King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan, including the King County regional earmarks for 1986 and King County's 1986 Community Development Block Grant Program Policies.

WHEREAS, King County is a member of the Community Development Block Grant Consortium, and

WHEREAS, King County as the official applicant is responsible to the Federal Government for all activities undertaken with Community Development Block Grant funds, and

WHEREAS, the 1985-1987 Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the governing body of King County and twenty-four incorporated jurisdictions within King County sets forth an arrangement for planning the distribution of Community Development Block Grant funds, and

WHEREAS, Federal Community Development Block Grant legislation requires King County to adopt an annual community development plan to guide the use of Community Development Block Grant funds and identify community development and housing needs, and

WHEREAS, the 1986 King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan (hereinafter referred to as the 1986 CDBG Consortium Plan) meets the Federal Community Development Block Grant requirements, and

WHEREAS, the formula for the distribution of county "population" funds among three designated regions of unincorporated King County: north and east, southeast and southwest; and countywide adopted in Motion 5746 is now incorporated in the 1986 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan, and

1 WHEREAS, citizens, all consortium members, King County
2 departments, and other non-county agencies participated in the
3 development of the 1986 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan through
4 review and comment, and

5 WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Committee approved the 1986 CDBG
6 Consortium Policy Plan and will be requested to approve the CDBG
7 Consortium Cities and King County CDBG Program Policies for the
8 1986 program year after approval by local councils, and

9 WHEREAS, the King County executive has submitted the 1986
10 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan including the proposed King County
11 1986 CDBG Program Policies;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

13 A. The attached 1986 King County Community Development
14 Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan including the King County
15 regional earmarks and the King County 1986 Community Development
16 Block Grant Program Policies, excluding specific Community
17 Development Area policies characterized as "unmet needs" are
18 hereby adopted to replace the 1985 King County Community
19 Development Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan and the 1985 King
20 County Community Development Block Grant Program Policies and to
21 govern the planning process and development of the 1986
22 Community Development Block Grant Program.

23 B. All eligible applications shall be given consideration.
