A MOTION supporting the city of Seattle's plans to pursue curbside residential recycling thereby diverting solid waste from the Cedar Hills landfill.

WHEREAS, King County and the city of Seattle have entered into an interlocal agreement concerning the use of King County solid waste disposal facilities, and

WHEREAS, the interlocal agreement between King County and the city of Seattle requires that the city shall submit to the county, no later than March 31 of each year, a three-year solid waste tonnage forecast, which includes an estimate of high and low waste reduction and waste recycling goals, and submit annually a report and analysis of the waste recycling and waste reduction programs the city has or will implement, and

WHEREAS, the city of Seattle plans to pursue a curbside recycling collection project expected to result in approximately 100,000 tons of waste being diverted from the Cedar Hills landfill in the first five years beginning February 1988 and has notified King County pursuant to the interlocal agreement, and

WHEREAS, King County is supportive of the curbside recycling collection diversion project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

King County supports the city of Seattle's proposed curbside recycling collection project, recognizes the city of Seattle's program is expected to divert approximately 100,000 tons of waste from Cedar Hills in the first five years beginning February 1988
