A MOTION requesting the executive to accelerate work on a new comprehensive sign control ordinance.

WHEREAS, the King County council has considered and adopted a new comprehensive ordinance regarding controls of billboards in King County, and

WHEREAS, the council decided to precede ahead with billboards prior to undertaking consideration of the related and larger issue of sign control in King County, and

WHEREAS, representatives of the sign and real estate industries offered to work cooperatively with King County in determining new controls, and

WHEREAS, the executive departments worked cooperatively with the council in developing the proposed billboard ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the need exists to undertake and overhaul the county's regulation and enforcement of controls on signs, including on-premise signs, temporary signs, and the enforcement against currently illegal signs in the right-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The executive is requested to accelerate development with input from interested parties for a comprehensive proposal regulating and enforcing controls on the use of signs in unincorporated King County for council consideration.
