A MOTION calling upon the State Department of Revenue to extend the deadline for valuation appeals until August 1, 1990.

WHEREAS, July 1 is the deadline for King County property owners to file appeals of real estate valuations with the King County Board of Appeals and Equalization, and;

WHEREAS, county officials in the past have emphasized to the public that increased valuations may not lead to higher property taxes, and;

WHEREAS, it now appears that increased valuations in 1990 may in fact result in substantially higher property taxes for many property owners,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County Council calls upon the state Department of Revenue to take the steps necessary to effectively extend the deadline for valuation appeals in King County until August 1, 1990.
