MOTION NO. 9011

A MOTION sponsoring an additional application for funding assistance for projects through the Metro Regional Shoreline Improvement Fund.

WHEREAS, King County is committed to the restoration and preservation of natural areas and water quality in our urban landscape, and

WHEREAS, the I'M. A. P.A.L. Foundation has had, over the past twelve years, a history of strong volunteer efforts and community involvement in the restoration of the Hamm Creek Basin, an area adjacent to Highway 509, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of an agreement between Metro and the city of Seattle, funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land and the construction of facilities for public access to, and enhancement of, regionally significant shorelines, and

WHEREAS, applicants for such funds must be sponsored and formally approved by a unit of local, county, state or tribal government in order to ensure permanent stewardship, and

WHEREAS, King County considers it in the best public interest to acquire the riparian property identified in paragraph C below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is authorized to add the Hamm Creek Basin Project to the sponsored list of applicants for the Metro Regional Shoreline Improvement Fund.

B. King County surface water management (SWM) is requested to act as a sponsor on behalf of the I'M. A. P.A.L. Foundation in its work on the Hamm Creek Basin program.

C. Any funding assistance so received shall be used for the reclamation and enhancement of Hamm Creek, a tributary of the Duwamish River.

1 D. Any property acquired with financial aid through the
2 Metro Regional Shoreline Improvement Fund shall be used in
3 accordance with the terms of financial aid specified by Metro.

4 E. This motion shall be part of the formal application to
5 the Metro Regional Shoreline Improvement Fund.
