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MOTION NO. **9488**

A MOTION relating to the allocation of cost savings resulting from the renegotiation of the marine patrol facility lease.

WHEREAS, King County Marine Patrol performs a critical public safety function, and

WHEREAS, the King County Marine Patrol's primary service delivery area is in the northern and eastern portions of Lake Washington, and

WHEREAS, a review conducted by the Marine Patrol Unit has determined that their optimal location is the Kirkland waterfront, and

WHEREAS, cost savings have resulted from the renegotiation of their facility lease at Carillon Point, Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, the unit has significant maintenance and equipment needs that have been deferred due to budgetary constraints;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Cost savings resulting from the renegotiation of the marine patrol facility lease be used exclusively for maintenance and equipment needs of the marine patrol and

1 that the executive provide an equipment purchasing and  
2 maintenance plan to the Budget and Fiscal Management  
3 Committee.
