2 A MOTION to name a tributary of Patterson Creek near Fall  
3 City as Haywitch Creek.  
4

5 WHEREAS, the unnamed stream located near Fall City is a tributary of the  
6 Patterson Creek, and

7 WHEREAS, a proposal to name the creek Haywitch Creek was submitted to the  
8 Washington State Board on Geographic Names by a teacher at the Fall City Elementary  
9 School and the fifth grade class, and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Haywitch was a Native American doctor who lived in a long  
11 house in the Snoqualmie Valley and reportedly died in 1907 at the age of 130, and

12 WHEREAS, the Washington State Board of Geographic Names denied the request  
13 because the proponents failed to demonstrate a strong historical connection between  
14 Haywitch and the creek and failed to provide sufficient historical documents to support the  
15 proposal, and

16 WHEREAS, the Washington State Board of Geographic Names based its decision  
17 in part on its belief that the council had no opinion on the naming of the creek;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

In recognition of an early pioneer of the Snoqualmie Valley, the naming of an unnamed stream located near Fall City as Haywitch Creek is hereby authorized.


