

ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF  
KING COUNTY APPROVING AND RATIFYING  
THE MERGER OF KITSAP COUNTY IN THE  
PUGET SOUND AIR POLLUTION CONTROL  
AGENCY

WHEREAS, by Chapter 238, Laws of 1967, the Legislature of the State of Washington created the enabling legislation for multi-county regional air pollution control authorities, and

WHEREAS, by Section 4, Chapter 238, the regional agency comprising King, Pierce and Snohomish Counties was directed to activate by operation of law on or before June 21, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the regional authority by and through the Board of Directors have met, adopted regulations, created a staff, obtained federal financing, adopted an air pollution control program and are operation pursuant to the laws of the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, ~~the~~ Tri-County authority has been designated and named the Puget Sound Air Pollution Control Agency, and

WHEREAS, Kitsap County is geographically, economically and socially attached to King, Pierce and Snohomish Counties, and the cities and towns located therein, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Air Pollution Control Board and the National Air Pollution Control Administration have recommended that Kitsap County join and merge with the Counties of King, Pierce and Snohomish in the air pollution control authority, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Puget Sound Air Pollution Control Authority have approved the merger and have recommended to the three Counties that the merger be approved, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Kitsap County has adopted a resolution, pursuant to Section 11, Chapter 238, Laws of 1967, as amended, RCW 70.94, merging Kitsap County and all

the cities and towns therein, to the regional air pollution control authority comprising King, Pierce and Snohomish Counties, and

WHEREAS, the County Council of King County deem it to be necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of King County and of the regional authority that Kitsap County be merged and joined as part of the Puget Sound Air Pollution Control Authority effective January 1, 1970.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. The County Council does hereby authorize, approve and ratify the merger of Kitsap County, and all the cities and towns therein, with King, Pierce and Snohomish Counties, and all cities and towns therein, in the Puget Sound Regional Air Pollution Control Authority, effective January 1, 1970.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Council is hereby directed to forward to the Secretary of State and to the Puget Sound Air Pollution Control Agency a certified copy of this resolution.
