

ORDINANCE NO. 00199 TO KING COUNTY TRAFFIC CODE
mxxxxxxxxxxxxx.

WHEREAS, by R.C.W. 46.61.415 the County Commissioners have the authority to establish speed limits on county roads outside any incorporated city or town, and,

WHEREAS, by virtue of King County Resolution No. 36096, King County passed a comprehensive traffic code, and,

WHEREAS, certain speed limits set forth in Schedules 1 through 5 should be changed, and,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that pursuant to traffic engineering studies, Schedule 3 setting maximum speed limit at 35 miles per hour should be and hereby is amended to delete the following street.

Southwest 149th Street, between Ambaum Boulevard and 23rd Avenue Southwest

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of King County Commissioners that the maximum safe speed at which vehicles of any character may be operated on the described roads is hereby fixed as described.
