

IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF South 124th Street & 50th Pl. South (42nd Ave. S. to Steel Hill Bridge, now Archie ~~County Road~~ Codiga Bridge)

Order of Establishment

Survey No. 10-23-4-22

In the matter of the establishment of the South 124th Street & 50th Place South (now Archie Codiga Bridge) Council (42nd Avenue South to Steel Hill Bridge / county road the Board finds as follows:

First. That the Motion No. 72 therefore was * passed on the 30th day of June, 19 69, and the Acting Director, Dept. of Public Works and the County Engineer was duly directed to examine and if necessary survey the route of said proposed road.

Second. That on the 26th day of June, 19 69, the Acting Director, Dept. of Public Works Council Engineer filed in the office of the Board his report in writing, and at the same time his field notes and profiles of the proposed road, and a map, as provided by law, and the 18th day of August, 19 69, was set as the day for hearing on said report, and notice of such hearing was duly given by publishing and posting as provided by law.

Third. That the Council Board, having considered said report and all evidence relative to the establishment of the road, and finding that such proposed road is a public necessity.

IT IS ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL BOARD, that the South 124th Street & 50th Place South Codiga Bridge (42nd Ave. South to Steel Hill Bridge now Archie / Road be established as follows:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of 42nd Ave. So., in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M., said point bearing N. 10° 47' 15" E. a distance of 1,324.95 ft. from the south 1/4 corner of said Section 10; thence in an Easterly direction a distance of 3,493.07 ft. to a terminus at the west edge of the Steel Hill Bridge, said terminus bearing N. 56° 27' 34" E. a distance of 833.27 ft. from the SW corner of Section 11, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.

3,493.07 Ft. = 0.66 Mile
