

ORDINANCE NO. 00251, KING COUNTY TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, by R.C.W 36.86.070 the County Council has the authority to designate certain county roads as arterial highways outside any incorporated city or town, and,

WHEREAS, by virtue of King County Resolution No. 36096, King County passed a comprehensive traffic code, and,

WHEREAS, certain arterial highways set forth in Schedule 13 should be changed, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE it resolved that pursuant to traffic engineering studies, Schedule 13 designating arterial highways should be and hereby is amended to add the following streets.

SOUTHEAST NEWPORT WAY BETWEEN F.A.I.
405 AND COAL CREEK PARKWAY SOUTHEAST

COAL CREEK PARKWAY SOUTHEAST BETWEEN
NEWPORT WAY AND SOUTHEAST 72ND STREET


NEWCASTLE ROAD BETWEEN SOUTHEAST 72ND
STREET AND S.R. 900 (RENTON-ISSAQUAH
ROAD)

138TH AVENUE SOUTHEAST BETWEEN S.R.
900 (RENTON-ISSAQUAH ROAD) AND SOUTHEAST
128TH STREET

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the King County Council that all vehicles entering the above roadway shall stop before entering.
