

ORDINANCE NO. 00317, KING COUNTY TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, by R.C.W. 46.61.570 the King County Council has the authority to prohibit or regulate the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on county roads outside any incorporated city or town, and,

WHEREAS, by virtue of King County Resolution No. 36096, King County passed a comprehensive traffic code, and,

WHEREAS, certain parking regulations set forth in Schedules 13 through 20 should be changed, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that pursuant to traffic engineering studies, Schedule 14 should be and hereby is amended to add the following street.

NORTH SIDE OF NORTHEAST 20TH STREET,  
WEST OF 148TH AVENUE NORTHEAST FOR  
APPROXIMATELY 350 FEET

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the above described parking restrictions be evidenced by signs posted by proper authority.
