

AUBURN-BLACK DIAMOND RD.
(H.H.HOWARD RD. TO KENT-
BLACK DIAMOND RD.)

Survey No. 18-21-6-6

County Road

In the matter of the establishment of Auburn-Black Diamond Road (H. H. Howard Road to Kent-Black Diamond Road) county road the Council finds as follows:

First. That the † Motion No. 120 therefore was * passed on the 15th day of December, 1969, and the County Engineer was duly directed to examine and if necessary survey the route of said proposed road.

Second. That on the 11th day of December, 1969, the County Engineer filed in the office of the Council his report in writing, and at the same time his field notes and profiles of the proposed road, and a map, as provided by law, and the 2nd day of February, 1970, was set as the day for hearing on said report, and notice of such hearing was duly given by publishing and posting as provided by law.

Third. That the Council, having considered said report and all evidence relative to the establishment of the road, and finding that such proposed road is a public necessity.

IT IS ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL, that the Auburn-Black Diamond Road (H. H. Howard Road to Kent-Black Diamond Road) Road be established as follows:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of H. H. Howard Road at Eng. Sta. 244+99.12 of King County Survey No. 18-21-6-1 in Sec. 18, Twp. 21 N., R. 6 E.W.M., thence NE'ly a distance of 781.68 feet to a terminus at the intersection of Kent-Black Diamond Road, said terminus being S. 52°32'14" W. a distance of 1066.92 feet from the north 1/4 corner of said Section 18.

781.68 feet = 0.15 miles

and as shown upon the field notes, profile and map of the County Engineer, and that from henceforth said road shall be a County Road of 100 feet in width exclusive of slopes for cuts and fills, and that the same be opened according to law.
