3 An ordinance relating to the establishment of a Disability
4 Board and defining its powers, duties and responsibilities.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 Section 1. The King County Disability Board for the Washing-
7 ton Law Enforcement Officers' and Fire Fighters' Retirement System
8 is hereby established pursuant to the authority of Section 11 (b),
9 Chapter 209, 1969 1st Ex. Sess.

10 Section 2. The Board shall be composed of five members to be
11 chosen as follows: One member of the King County Council appoint-
12 ed by the King County Council; one member of a city or town within
13 the county, excluding those cities and towns with established Dis-
14 ability Boards, chosen by the majority of the Mayors of such cities
15 and towns from the respective legislative bodies of such cities and
16 towns; one fire fighter to be elected by the fire fighters subject
17 to the jurisdiction of the County Disability Board; one law enforce-
18 ment officer to be elected by the law enforcement officers subject
19 to the jurisdiction of the County Disability Board; and one member
20 of the public-at-large who resides within the area of jurisdiction
21 of the County Disability Board, appointed by the other four appoint-
22 ed members heretofore designated in this section. All members ap-
23 pointed shall serve for two year terms.

24 Section 3. The Board shall perform all functions, exercise
25 all powers, and make all such determinations as specified in Chap-
26 ter 209, 1969 1st Ex. Sess. of the Laws of the State of Washington.

27 Section 4. The Board shall have jurisdiction over all mem-
28 bers of the Washington Law Enforcement ~~Retirement~~ Officers' and
29 Fire Fighters' Retirement System employed by the County of King,
30 the Fire Districts in the unincorporated areas of King County and
31 the cities and towns without established Disability Boards.

32 Section 5. The members of the Board shall serve without com-
