

ORDINANCE NO. 00359, KING COUNTY TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, by R.C.W. 46.61.415 the King County Council has the authority to establish speed limits on county roads outside any incorporated city or town, and,

WHEREAS, by virtue of King County Resolution No. 36096, King County passed a comprehensive traffic code, and,

WHEREAS, certain speed limits set forth in Schedules 1 through 5 should be changed, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained that pursuant to traffic engineering studies, Schedule 5 setting maximum speed limit at 45 miles per hour should be and hereby is amended to add the following streets.

AIRPORT WAY, Seattle City Limits to S.R. 181.

EAST VALLEY HIGHWAY, (Old S.R. 167) between South 180th Street and approximately South 192nd Street.

ENUMCLAW-FRANKLIN ROAD, between S.R. 169 and Green River Gorge Road.

GREEN RIVER GORGE ROAD, between Black Diamond Town Limits and Enumclaw-Franklin Road.

228TH AVENUE SOUTHEAST, between Inglewood Hill Road and Issaquah-Pine Lake Road.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the King County Council that the maximum safe speed at which vehicles of any character may be operated on the described roads is hereby fixed as described.
