

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation to the City of Des Moines of unincorporated territory contiguous thereto.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

SECTION 1. The City of Des Moines, by its Resolution No. 143

has determined that the best interests and general welfare of the City of Des Moines would be served by this annexation of unincorporated territory contiguous thereto as described in said Resolution No. 143.

SECTION 2. Said Resolution further satisfies the provisions of R.C.W. 35.13.015 and prays for the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein upon the question of annexation.

SECTION 3. Said proposed annexation has previously been approved by the King County Boundary Review Board pursuant to R.C.W. Chapter 36.93.100.

SECTION 4. The question of annexation shall be placed on the ballot for vote by the qualified voters residing within the territory sought to be annexed on the 1st day of December 1970.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 5th day of October, 1970.
