

ORDINANCE  
NO. 1185

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of  
SE 192nd Street (102nd Avenue SE to 108th  
Avenue SE)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: That the Director of the Department of Public  
Works has made an examination of SE 192nd Street (102nd Avenue SE  
to 108th Avenue SE) along the course and description as set forth  
below, and had made a favorable report upon same, as required by  
law.

Section 2: That said road be established not less than 60  
feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the  
following described centerline:

Beginning on the north line of Section 5, Twp. 22 N.,  
Rge. 5 East, W.M. at a point 654.63 feet easterly of the  
NW corner thereof, thence in an easterly direction a  
distance of 1969.79 feet to a terminus at a point on  
the centerline of 108th Avenue SE (SR 515), said point  
being the N  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 5.

1,969.79 Feet = 0.37 Mile

Section 3: That the King County Council finds that the  
establishment of said roadway, along the course and description  
set forth, is a public necessity.
