

1 AN ORDINANCE Relating to the application of CLEARVIEW T.V. CABLE
2 OF ENUMCLAW for a franchise to construct, maintain and operate
3 transmission and distribution of television, FM radio and other
4 audiovisual electric signals.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1: The franchise extends upon, over, along, underneath
7 and across county roads, and rights of way existing now and as may be
8 constructed in the future within the area described as follows:

- 9 1. Portions of 4 Sections in Township 23 N., R 5 East W.M.,
10 totaling 1600 Acres more or less.

11 The East-half of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, EXCEPT the incorporated
12 area of the City of Renton. All of Section 22, EXCEPT the S. $\frac{1}{2}$
13 of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$, and the S. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$.
14 All of Section 23, EXCEPT the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$. All of Section 24
15 EXCEPT the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$.

16 SECTION 2: The above matter has come regularly for hearing before the
17 King County Council and it appearing that:

- 18 1. The application was properly made.
19 2. The application was referred to the County Executive for
20 investigation of the feasibility thereof and the checking of the
21 plans and description of the location thereof.
22 3. The County Executive has made such investigation and has filed
23 with the Council his report and recommendation as follows:

24 for Date of Hearing

- 25 4. Due and legal notice of said application and of this hearing
26 thereon has been given by posting and publication in the manner
27 and as required by law.

28 SECTION 3: The application of CLEARVIEW T.V. OF ENUMCLAW is
29 approved and the franchise is granted as approved. The same shall be
30 executed on behalf of King County by the County Executive.
