

## O R D I N A N C E

NO. 1323

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of South 272nd Street (Pacific Highway South (SR 99) to F.A.I. 5)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: That the Director of the Department of Public Works has made an examination of South 272nd Street (Pacific Highway South to F.A.I. 5) along the course and description as set forth below, and has made a favorable report upon same, as required by law.

Section 2: That said road be established not less than 60 feet and not more than 84 feet in width, having not less than 30 feet and not more than 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning on the north line of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M. at a point 947.32 feet easterly of the northwest corner of said Section 33, said point also being the intersection of South 272nd Street and Pacific Highway South; thence easterly 2366.34 feet to a terminus on the centerline of South 272nd Street, said point being on the north line of said Section 33, 680.49 feet easterly of the North quarter corner of said Section 33.

ALSO, Leg "A" beginning at a point on the centerline of Star Lake Road at Sta. 20+97.47 of King County Survey No. 28-22-4-6, said point being S 62°08'56"W a distance of 685.18 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; thence N 1°00'34"E a distance of 332.31 feet to a point on the North line of said Section 33, 600.08 feet west of said North quarter corner, said terminus being on the centerline of South 272nd Street at Sta. 10+85.77 of King County

Section 3: That the King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
