

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 1418

AN ORDINANCE appropriating funds to the Office of Budgets and Accounts for new employees and amending Ordinance No. 1056, Section 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$6,050 is hereby appropriated from the Executive Contingency Account in Special Programs to the Office of Budgets and Accounts to fund employment of a Chief Accountant and Financial Systems Analyst during the remainder of 1972; PROVIDED THAT they not become members of the Career Service until their permanent positions become effective with the 1973 budget and that the salaries for these two positions for the first six months of 1973 will be at step B of ranges 65 and 57 respectively as now defined in Ordinance 1282.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1056, Section 2., as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
