

ORDINANCE NO. 1425

3 AN ORDINANCE establishing Television Reception
4 Improvement District No. 1, King County,
5 Washington, in Skykomish Precinct and a portion
6 of Stevens Precinct; establishing a board of
7 three members.

9 PREAMBLE: The formation of a television improvement dis-
10 trict in the upper Skykomish Valley shall be to serve the public
11 interest, convenience and necessity in the construction, mainten-
12 ance and operation of television translator stations, including
13 appropriate electric or electronic devices for increasing tele-
14 vision program distribution, but said purposes are not meant to
15 include the construction or operation of television cable systems,
16 commonly known and referred to as cable TV systems or CATV.

17 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

18 SECTION I. There is hereby established a district desig-
19 nated Television Reception Improvement District No. 1, King
20 County, Washington. The boundaries of the proposed district
21 shall:

22 Begin at the northwest corner of Sec. 3, T. 26 N., R.
23 10 E.; thence south along the west boundary lines of
24 Secs. 3, 10, 15, 22, 27, and 34 to its southwest corner,
25 of T. 26 N., R. 10 E.; thence east along the south
26 boundary of T. 26 N. to the King County-Chelan County
27 line; thence north along the King County-Chelan County
28 line to the King County-Snohomish County line; thence
29 west along the King County-Snohomish County line to the
30 northwest corner of Sec. 3, T. 26 N., R. 10 E., the
31 point of beginning.

32 SECTION 2. There is hereby established a Board of Tele-
33 vision Reception Improvement District No. 1, King County,
Washington, to be composed of three members appointed by the King
County Council. Each member shall reside within the boundaries
of the district. Each member shall serve a three-year term
except that on the first board one of the members shall be ap-
pointed to a one year term and two to two year terms.

A majority of the members of the board shall constitute a
quorum for the transaction of business, but the majority vote

1 of the board members shall be necessary for any action taken by
2 the board. The board shall elect from its members a chairman
3 and such other officers as may be necessary. In the event a
4 vacancy occurs prior to the expiration of the member's term, the
5 Council shall appoint a person to complete the unexpired term.

6 SECTION 3. The District's board shall comply with all
7 regulations for operation and tax authorization as prescribed by
8 Chapter 155, Laws of 1971, 1st Extraordinary Session.
