

ORDINANCE NO. 2844

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$297,069 to the River Improvement Fund from the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration for flood damage repair work which resulted from the flood of December 1975 in King County amending Ordinance 2544, Section 46, as amended and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$297,069 is hereby appropriated to the River Improvement Fund from the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration as the second phase of flood damage repair work which will be conducted by King County as a result of the December 1975 flood.

PROVIDED:

- A. Ordinance No. 2562 provided a \$325,000 loan from the Current Expense Fund to the River Improvement Fund to provide initial funds for flood damage repair within King County.
- B. Of the \$325,000 initial loan amount, that portion which is anticipated to be reimbursed from the FDAA is \$265,100. Of this amount, \$152,394 is currently being held in reserve by the FDAA for final audit and an additional \$26,350 is anticipated reserve for supplemental projects.
- C. The remaining portion of the loan will be repaid contingent upon the capacity of the year end River Improvement Fund balance.
- D. To complete the second major portion of flood damage repair, the full \$297,069 from FDAA will remain in the River Improvement Fund.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 46, is hereby amended to read as follows:






