AN ORDINANCE relating to compensation for travel, providing for additional compensation under the monthly allotment system of reimbursement for use of privately owned vehicles for County business, increasing mileage allowance, authorizing a system of per diem rates of allowance; amending Ordinance 1902, Section 2; amending Ordinance 2030, Section 2; and K.C.C. 3.20.040; and adding a new section to K.C.C. Chapter 3.20.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1902, Section 2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Said compensation shall not exceed 80% of the average monthly charge billed by the Motor Pool for equivalent vehicles, except that additional compensation may be allowed on a mileage basis for travel outside King County.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2030, Section 2, and K.C.C. 3.20.040 are each amended to read as follows:

Any county employee who uses his private automobile in the performance of his official duties shall be allowed a reimbursement of ~~((thirteen))~~ fifteen cents for each mile of necessary travel, except as may be provided by collective bargaining agreements.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 3. Reimbursement for subsistence and lodging incurred in official business by elective and appointive officials and county employees shall be on an actual expenses basis and shall be detailed in accordance with general laws of the State of Washington; except that the executive, legislative and judicial branches of the county may at their individual option establish a system of per diem rates of allowance, not exceeding twenty-five dollars in lieu of subsistence and lodging to elective and appointive officials and county employees while on official business away

from their designated posts of duty but within the State of Washington,
and not exceeding thirty-five dollars per day while engaged on official
business elsewhere.
