ORDINANCE NO. 3169

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Enchanted Village to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a February 2, 1977, Notice of Intention indicating a petition for annexation of 12.12 acres of land was sufficient, containing signatures of 60% of the land owners, and by Resolution 76-517 concurred with the proposed annexation. The District filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance, dated February 7, 1977, on the proposed annexation. The District has a County approved comprehensive plan as required in Ordinance No. 1709, as amended.

2. The Boundary Review Board has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 36.39.170 and has found that the proposed annexation adequately meets the objectives enumerated in RCW 36.93.180.

3. The King County Council held a public hearing on the 25th day of April, 1977, has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060 and has found the proposed annexation to be adequately consistent with such criteria and to be in the public interest.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as Enchanted Village and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Enchanted Village to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., King County Washington, lying Southwesterly of the centerline of Secondary State Highway No. 5-D and Southeasterly of Primary State Highway No. 1, as conveyed to the State of Washington by deed recorded under Auditor's File No. 5013794, King County, Washington;
