ORDINANCE NO. 3371

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$71,455 in additional revenue to the Mental Health/Mental Retardation Fund from an increase in the National Institute of Drug Abuse (NIDA) drug abuse grant and to be used to provide sixty-seven (67) additional treatment slots, amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 46.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$71,455 in additional revenue to the Mental Health/Mental Retardation Fund from an increase in National Institute of Drug Abuse drug abuse grant to be used to provide sixty-seven (67) additional treatment slots.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 46 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Mental Health/Mental Retard. ((~~\$8,117,072~~)) \$8,189,427

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2988, Section 46, as amended, shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 3. The Executive is hereby authorized to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Snohomish County for the allocation of twenty-two (22) of the sixty-seven (67) drug abuse treatment slots to be funded by this ordinance.
