ORDINANCE NO. 5056

AN ORDINANCE approving additions and betterments to the Water District 19 Comprehensive Plan as adopted by district Resolution No. 418.

PREAMBLE:

On September 17, 1979, the King County Council granted interim approval to the Water District No. 19 Comprehensive Plan with the adoption of Ordinance No. 4493.

On June 10, 1980, Water District No. 19 adopted Resolution No. 418 providing for additions and betterments to its comprehensive plan.

On June 11, 1980, the manager of Water District No. 19 signed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance stating that the proposal would not have a significant adverse impact upon the environment.

On July 16, 1980, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed additions and betterments, as provided in KCC 13.24, and recommended their approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The additions and betterments to the Water District No. 19 Comprehensive Plan as adopted by district Resolution No. 418 (attached) are hereby approved.
