

ORDINANCE NO. 6250

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Head Start Program; amending Ordinance 6066, Section 22, and K.C.C. Title 2; and declaring an emergency.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6066, Section 22, and K.C.C. Title 2 is hereby amended as follows:

DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES. Effective January 1, 1983, there shall be established a Department of Human Resources. The department is responsible to manage, be fiscally accountable for the following assigned programs and divisions:

A. DIVISION OF HUMAN SERVICES. The functions of the division include:

1. Manage and operate an involuntary treatment program.
2. Allocate funds to agencies for the provision of mental health and developmental disability and aging services; and accordingly, write applicable contracts, verify billings and authorize fiscal reimbursement.
3. Provide staff support and liaison to appropriate advisory boards and other governmental agencies in their

1 performance of planning and allocation processes.

2 4. Provide information and referral services to the
3 general public.

4 B. DIVISION OF COMMUNITY SERVICES.

5 1. The principal function of the division is to manage and
6 operate the following programs:

7 a. Community youth services programs

8 b. Veteran's Relief

9 c. Women's Program

10 d. Cooperative Extension Service

11 e. Public Defense.

12 (~~f. Head Start, unless the county declines to act as~~

14 2. The management function, as appropriate, shall include:

15 a. The development of annual plans for service;

16 b. The development of annual operating budgets for the
17 review and approval of authorizing funding agencies;

18 c. The development and implementation of program
19 modifications necessitated by changes in funding levels or
20 policy;

21 d. The delivery of services to the public, or the
22 allocation of funds for contracted services, as applicable;

23 e. The monitoring of program services, including, as
24 applicable, the enforcement of appropriate negotiated contracts
25 between the county and service providing agencies.

26 3. As a subordinate function the division, as necessary,
27 shall provide information and referral services to the general

SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
