AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of 20th Way South.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: The director of the department of public works has made an examination of 20th Way South between South 330th Street and South 325th Street along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by RCW 36.81.050.

Section 2: Said road shall be established not less than 56 feet in width, having 28 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Commencing at the intersection of South 330th Street and 20th Avenue South as shown and so delineated on supplemental State Plat, recorded in Volume 42 of plats, pages 23 and 24, records of King County, thence along the centerline of said 20th Avenue South N 01°12'13" E 447.89 feet to a point also defined as being N 32°40'04" E 2827.36 feet from the Southwest corner of Section 16, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., said point also the true point of beginning of this centerline description and the beginning of a tangent curve to the left having a radius of 185 feet; thence northerly and northwesterly 259.64 feet along said curve through a central angle of 80°24'47" to a point of reverse curvature; thence 241.70 feet along a tangent curve to the right having a radius of 320 feet and a central angle of 43°16'34" to the point of tangency; thence N 35°56'00" W 558.12 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve to the left having a radius of 400 feet; thence westerly and northerly 365.96 feet along said curve through a central angle of 52°25'14" to the point of tangency; thence N 88°21'14" W 74.00 feet to the terminus of this centerline and from said terminus the west one-quarter corner of said Section 16 bears S 30°34'54" W 788.32 feet.

Contains 89,437 square feet or 2.05 acres more or less.
Total length = 1499.42 feet.

Section 3: In addition to the above described road, a road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width having 30 feet of such width on each side of the following described centerline: said centerline bearing

northeasterly of and intersecting the above described course at station 1+21.94.

Said centerline being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point defined as being on a tangent curve to the left with a radius of 185.00 feet an arc distance of 121.94 feet from the point of curvature through a central angle of 37°45'56" to the true point of beginning; thence 91.16 feet along a tangent curve to the left having a radius of 100 feet and a central angle of 52°14'04" to the intersection of the centerline of 20th Avenue South and the terminus.

Total length = 91.16 feet.

Section 4: King County council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
