AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$2,040,410 to the River Improvement Fund 105 and \$1,200,000 to the Surface and Stormwater Management CIP Fund [318] to repair damage from the November 1995 storm supported by \$2,427,234 in anticipated state and federal grants, \$41,403 from the Green River Flood Control Zone District, \$417,773 in available River Improvement Fund balance, and appropriating \$300,000 from Reet #1 CIP fund balance to the SWM CIP Fund [318] and amending Ordinance 12029, Sections 68, 80 and 110 and attachment 2, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$2,040,410 to the River Improvement Fund 105 to repair damage from the November 1995 storm.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 12029, Section 68, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

RIVER IMPROVEMENT - From the River Improvement Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

River Improvement \$2,040,410

PROVIDED THAT the funds appropriated by this ordinance is for the projects identified in Attachment 1.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 12029, Section 80, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

BUDGETS - REET #1 - CIP - From the REET Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Budgets - REET #1 - CIP \$300,000

SECTION 4. Ordinance 12029, Section 110, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PROVIDED THAT this appropriation provides for the disbursement of the REET funds appropriated in Section 3, as shown in Attachment 1.


SECTION 5. Ordinance 12029, Attachment 2, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:


