

ORDINANCE NO. **12857**

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AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$4,706,888 to the Road Fund; \$3,057,850 of various project appropriations and disappropriations in the Road Construction Fund; \$630,000 of various project appropriations in the Renton Maintenance Facility Construction Fund; \$1,100,000 to the County Road Improvement District Guaranty Fund; and \$198,866 to the Arterial Highway Development Fund to cover 1996 and 1997 storms-related road repair and emergency response costs, amending Ordinance 12538, Sections 61, 107, and 108, Attachments 2 and 3, as amended.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

ORDINANCE NO. **12859**

AN ORDINANCE approving a franchise for Soos Creek Water and Sewer District to construct, operate and maintain a water system in Council Districts 6, 9, 12 and 13, and authorizing the Executive to execute the franchise agreement.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

1. The Soos Creek Water and Sewer District has filed an application for a franchise to consolidate all its current and expired franchises in council districts 6, 9, 12 and 13 to construct, operate and maintain a water system to serve residential, multi-family and commercial areas in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010 and K.C.C. 6.27.
2. The district's comprehensive plan was approved on February 10, 1997, by King County Council Ordinance 12645.
3. The application has been referred to the relevant county departments for review.
4. The King County executive has recommended approval of the franchise.
5. The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed and approved the district's franchise, legal description and map on September 10, 1996.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The granting of a franchise to the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District to construct, operate and maintain a water system within King County is hereby approved. The King County executive is authorized to enter into and execute the water system franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated herein. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.
