1 AN ORDINANCE approving the King County Water
2 District Number 19 Water System Plan.

4 PREAMBLE

5 1. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water
6 utilities as a prerequisite for granting right-of-way franchises and approval of
7 right-of-way construction permits.

8 2. The King County Water District Number 19 Water System Plan (plan)
9 discusses water service to existing and future populations within the district's
10 service area on Vashon Island. The area is predominantly comprised of single-
11 family residences, although commercial and industrial uses are also served. The
12 service area has the potential for a large amount of growth.

13 3. The district has been in moratorium since 1996 because of concerns about
14 providing water during periods of peak demand with existing water sources and
15 water rights. A new monitoring program undertaken by the district will examine
16 stream flow and customer use to allow for more efficient management of the
17 water resources, including consideration of instream flows. This new approach,

18 in combination with changes to state code, has already allowed the equivalent of
19 forty more households to be connected to the system.

20 4. The King County utilities and technical review committee (UTRC) reviewed
21 and conditionally approved the plan on May 10, 2000. The conditions of UTRC
22 approval, technical changes to the plan, have been met and are reflected in the
23 final version attached to this ordinance.

24 5. The district prepared a determination of nonsignificance for the plan on April
25 11, 2000, in accordance with the state Environmental Policy Act.

26 6. The district approved the plan on April 11, 2000. The UTRC recommends that
27 the council approve the plan.

28 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**






