THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

SE 168th Street((S.R. 515 (Benson Highway) Easterly
1329.05 feet))

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King
County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as
SE 168th Street


be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of
such width each side of the following described centerline.

Beginning at the center Section 29, Township 23 North,
Range 5 East, W.M., said point being the intersection
of Benson Highway (S.R. 515) and SE 168th Street;
thence in an easterly direction a distance of 1329.05
feet to a terminus on the centerline of SE 168th Street;
said terminus being the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$
of said Section 29.


The King County Council finds that the establishment of said
roadway along the course and description set forth is a public
necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public
Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same
as required by law.
