A Motion Relating to the Seattle-King
County Department of Public Health
Rules and Regulations

WHEREAS, there is much controversy relating to the Seattle-
King County Department of Public Health's Rules and Regulations
for Construction and Installation of Sewage Waste Disposal Systems,
as revised October 1971; and

WHEREAS, it is to the advantage of all concerned with septic
tank installation and design that an amicable agreement be reached;
now, therefore,

BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County that a request be
made of the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health that
the Rules and Regulations as revised in October 1971, be held in
abeyance until the King County Council Citizens' Health and Safety
Committee has had an opportunity to formulate policy guidelines
in conjunction with the Health Department concerning possible
amendments to Ordinance No. 931 and these Rules and Regulations;
and that the 1964 Rules and Regulations of the Health Department
remain in effect until such time as agreement has been reached
by all concerned.

thereof on the 17th day of January, 1972.
