2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
3 to execute and submit a grant application
4 to the State Law & Justice Planning Office
5 for funds in the amount of \$39,265 to link
6 the King County Prosecuting Attorney's
7 Office with the SEA-KING ALERT information
8 system.

9 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
10 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
11 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of
12 Justice, through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning
13 Office, and,

14 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need of govern-
15 ment to have accurate information systems available to make
16 intelligent decisions affecting its citizens, and,

17 WHEREAS, the King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office
18 would benefit from this grant by having a more comprehensive
19 information system at its disposal to pursue the public interest,
20 and,

21 WHEREAS, this grant will link the Prosecuting Attorney's
22 Office to an existing SEA-KING ALERT information system, thereby
23 enhancing coordination and cooperation of law enforcement and
24 judicial agencies,

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized
27 to make application for funds in the amount of \$39,265 to the
28 State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

29 2. That King County recognizes a cash match in the
30 amount of \$18,162 from the King County Prosecuting Attorney's
31 Office Current Expense Fund in support of this project;

32 3. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
33 directed to file and execute such application and contracts
as are required by the State;


4. That the Federal State Relations Division is hereby authorized to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the State and to act as the authorized correspondent for King County;
