MOTION NO. 1113

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit grant applications to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration and the State, Economic Assistance Authority for funds in the amount of \$62,879 and \$44,698 to build a heavy aircraft crossing at Boeing Field International, 73-PW-329.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, is empowered to make grant awards for the construction and improvement of public airports, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, Economic Assistance Authority also provides for the award of grants pursuant to Chapter 117, Laws of 1972, 1st Executive Session, for the construction of public facilities, and

WHEREAS, Boeing Field International is in need of a heavy aircraft crossing taxiway in order to accomodate increasingly heavy aircraft operations, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide approximately \$14,471 in in-kind contribution for support of this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount \$62,879 to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration on behalf of King County.

2. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$44,698 to the State of Washington, Economic Assistance Authority on behalf of King County;

3. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the Federal Aviation Administration and the State of Washington.
