MOTION NO. 1118

A MOTION relating to a bicycle racing track at Marymoor Park.

WHEREAS, interest in bicycling as a form of recreation is increasing in popularity, and

WHEREAS, there is presently no bicycle racing track in the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the nearest tracks are located in Portland, Oregon and Vancouver, British Columbia, and

WHEREAS, the Redmond area has been a center for bicycle enthusiasm for over 40 years, and

WHEREAS, the County has endorsed the concept of a racing track in Marymoor Park and authorized its design consultants to prepare plans for such a track, and

WHEREAS, Marymoor Park is in a developmental stage, and

WHEREAS, the 1973 Capital Improvement Plan Budget for Phase II development of Marymoor Park as a regional Park includes a bicycle track, and

WHEREAS, the Citizens of the County have evidenced a deep interest in the project,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County;

The King County Executive shall proceed with the construction of a bicycle racing track at Marymoor Park built to Olympic specifications, to be completed by the end of 1973.


1 Funds to pay for the construction of the racing track shall
