MOTION NO. 1740

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into a lease agreement for Crane Pit with the King County Fire Chiefs Association and the Washington State Fire Chiefs Association.

WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes 28 cities and towns and 36 fire districts serving King County residents, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council is desirous of seeing fire fighters trained to combat fires which cause loss of life and property, and


WHEREAS, the King County Council is also desirous of lending its support and cooperation to see that these fire controllers are trained to the fullest in modern knowledge, methods and techniques of preventing, combating and controlling fires in King County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council of King County authorizes the King County Executive to execute a lease agreement with the King County Fire Chiefs Association and the Washington State Fire Chiefs Association for the use of Crane Pit, owned by King County and located in Enumclaw, to be used for the training of fire fighters in preventing, combating and controlling fires.


