A MOTION relating to the National Association of Counties and encouraging the National Association of Counties Board to choose Seattle as the site of its 1982 National Association of Counties Convention.

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties Board is considering Seattle and Milwaukee as the site of its 1982 national convention, and

WHEREAS, the Governor, the Seattle Mayor and the King County Executive have all extended a warm invitation to the National Association of Counties to hold their 1982 convention in Seattle, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County Convention and Visitors Bureau has extended an invitation and detailed response to NACo's requirements to support a projected attendance of 4,100 to 4,500 delegates during the week of July 7th through 14th, 1982.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The National Association of Counties Board of Directors is encouraged and warmly invited to choose Seattle as the site of its 1982 NACo Convention.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

The County Council pledges its enthusiastic and firm support to the NACo Board in its decision to host the 1982 NACo Convention in Seattle.
