2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 make a grant application for funds in the
4 approximate amount of \$32,550 to support a
Community Energy Demonstration Project, Grant
File No. 011:2.

6 WHEREAS, the Washington State Energy Office is empowered to
7 make grants to support Community Energy Demonstration Projects,
8 and has requested local government proposals, and

9
10 WHEREAS, King County, the City of Seattle, and the State of
11 Washington have adopted, or are preparing to adopt, comprehensive
12 Energy Codes for all new construction, and

13
14 WHEREAS, the King County Council passed Motion #4715 which
15 called for actions by the County Executive and the Building and
16 Land Development Division to facilitate the implementation of the
17 Energy Code, and

18
19 WHEREAS, the Energy Code will require additional staff time
20 and expertise to efficiently administer its requirements, and

21
22 WHEREAS, the Energy Code calls for flexibility and alterna-
23 tive approaches for complying with its technical requirements,
24 while providing equivalent energy savings, and

25
26 WHEREAS, the Energy Code, or similar code, will be required
27 in all jurisdictions in the state, and the State Energy Conser-
28 vation Program has set aside 1980 program funds for Community
29 Energy Demonstration Projects for proposals that are of general
30 benefit to all communities in the state in conserving energy
31 resources, and

33 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support
improved efficiency measures for building permit processing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$32,550 to the Washington State Energy Office for a Community Energy Demonstration Project on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The Washington State Energy Office is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
