WHEREAS, The office of County Executive will become
vacant at noon, January 14, 1981 upon the assumption of the
office of Governor of the state of Washington by John D. Spellman
and

WHEREAS, in accordance with amendment 52 (Art.II, Sec.15)
of the Washington State Constitution, the King County Republican
Central Committee on December 13, 1980 nominated three persons
for consideration by the County Council for appointment to the
office of County Executive upon vacation of that office by
John D. Spellman when he assumes the office of governor, and


WHEREAS, the list of the three nominees was delivered to
